**POSITION:** **Critical Infrastructure Analyst**  
National Incident Management Systems and Advanced Technologies (NIMSAT)  
Institute, University of Louisiana at Lafayette

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** A major focus of the NIMSAT Institute is to conduct research and develop tools to help quantify the impact of hazards, whether man-made, technological or natural, on the critical infrastructures and key resources (CI/KR), and the private sector supply chains that depend on these CI/KR. The successful candidate will serve as the liaison between the Institute and its stakeholders in the area of critical infrastructure protection and resiliency. He/she will contribute to the Institute's national-scale efforts related to CI/KR interdependency analyses and will develop studies leading to enhanced understanding of the dependency of private sector supply chains on CI/KR. In addition he/she will serve as the channel for the collection of public and private sector stakeholder needs, requirements and data that will serve to inform the NIMSAT Institute's R&D directions. He/she will provide technical and operational support to clients seeking to utilize the NIMSAT Institute's R&D products for the assessment and prioritization of critical infrastructure mitigation, protection, response, and recovery efforts. The successful candidate will be the primary interface of the NIMSAT Institute with the government and private sector stakeholders, and will participate in exercises conducted by the NIMSAT Institute in the CI/KR arena.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's degree in Business, Engineering, Homeland Security, Emergency Management or a closely related field. Applicants with appropriate military or intelligence analysis experience will be strongly considered. Strong verbal and written communication skills coupled with excellent interpersonal skills are a requirement. Good organizational, managerial, analytical and problem solving skills are desired with preference to candidates demonstrating them in the private sector context.

**ENVIRONMENT:** The National Incident Management Systems and Advanced Technologies (NIMSAT) Institute, a homeland security and disaster management institute at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, has been established with the goal of enhancing the resiliency of the Nation to natural and technological hazards.
